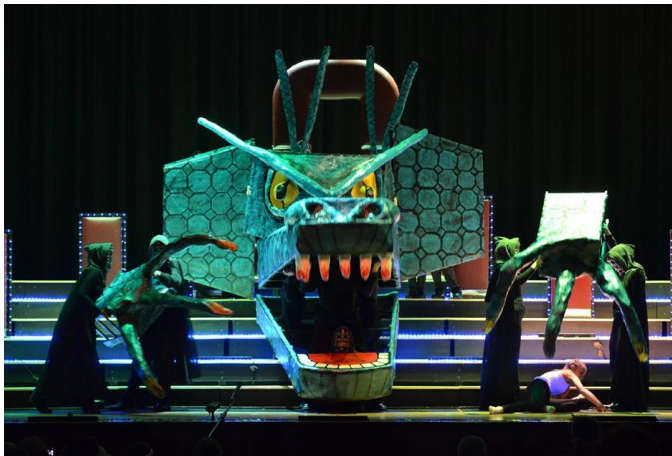


Dear CDS Students,

Here is our dragon puppet named "Lucy" which is short for "Lucifer" because Ambassador Draegon turned into THE DRAGON! Julianne Caccavale (as Zerube) battled the dragon and won by surrendering to God's will and the prophecy. The dragon puppet was operated by 17 performers. Each piece of the dragon took at least 5 hours to frame in wood (5x8). Each piece took 4 to 8 hours to chicken wire for a total that is over 80 hours to construct. Plus, 20 people worked 4 weeks to paper mache Lucy. Painting required one week, non-stop, with five people helping Rev. Kim.

Heart for People – Going to Uganda - A Vision Trip

After the Camp show, Sarah Harrs, Cece Harrs, Emma Worrall, Rev. Kim, and Mark will be going to Uganda from July 17 to July 31. We will be visiting Segawa, Mama Eva, Job, Lillian, Adorable, Eva, Grace, Kato Peter, and all the students in the five schools we support. We are also going to visit new schools and leaders who have been requesting our partnership. We will be travelling from Kampala to Kasese on a **VISION TRIP** to continue developing a long term relationship and a common vision with our partners in Uganda. Rev. Kim will be making plans with Ugandans for a **VISION TRIP** to lead roughly 20 American teachers and/or school administrators to Uganda in 2018. The hope is to inspire leaders within American schools. Ben Duphiney is also going to Uganda with his father and Sister Cecelia from Morris Catholic High School. They will be visiting Sister Cecelia's family and school in western Uganda.
